We're so excited to resume our "in-person" worship service beginning this **Sunday, June 14 at 9am ONLY** for our first phase of re-opening! Church will look a little different, so here is what you can expect. We will add our second additional service as we deem necessary. We will have family-style services, since there will be **NO nursery or children's ministry** during this first phase. Social distancing and masks are recommended by the governor's office. The facilities will be sanitized before and after each service.

Sunday Worship Service – What to expect?

- An approximate 50-minute service to minimize exposure time.
- A maximum of 50 seating capacity in the upper level, with an overflow of up to 30 people in the lower level who can participate via livestream on the monitors. Families will be seated together.
- Signage about social distancing, hand washing, cautions, etc. – will be in place to simply keep us aware and informed.
- Limited access and touch points throughout the building. Doors will be opened for you, hand sanitizer and masks will be available. Temperatures will be taken on all staff, volunteers and congregants. Ushers will be seating you upon arrival from front to back.
- We will have drop boxes for tithes and offerings at both entrance and exits.
- After service is over, we kindly ask you and your family to exit the building according to our designated exit strategy. We encourage fellowship with family and friends outside when the service has concluded.

THANK YOU for your faithfulness during this uncommon time in our nation's history, your faithfulness opens the door for God's continued blessing upon you and your family.
